The ASU PADI SCUBA Certification is a win / win situation. Through the text “Go Diving”, Videos, Knowledge Reviews, Quizzes and Lectures we will give you the information to become a safe and competent diver. In an effort to become a PADI Certified SCUBA Diver, you the student must be part of the process and agree to do the following:

- _____ • Complete the PADI Student Record File found in the Open Water Crewpak and fill out the Medical Questionnaire and have a doctor sign off (if necessary).
- _____ • Provide your basic snorkeling equipment (mask, snorkel, fins, booties, and gloves)
- _____ • Before every class, read the modules required for the class in the “Go Diving” text. It is easy to fall behind, so don’t wait until the last minute! Plan extra study time for Modules 4 and 5.
- _____ • Before every class, watch the videos that correspond with the “Go Diving” text.
- _____ • Before every class, complete the “Knowledge Review” homework sections after every module.
- _____ • Bring your snorkeling gear, log book, and the PADI RDP to all class sessions.

In addition, please show up on time and be prepared for class. Make up classes are done at the private rate of \$50/hour.

For ocean dive days:

- Pick up your equipment the day before the dive and carefully inspect it. Inflate the BCD and check for leaks, pressurize the regulator and check tank pressure, check for leaks as well as computer battery level and the condition of the mouthpieces.
- Bring sunscreen, warm clothing, rain gear, a hat, food, water, and your log books
- Get plenty of rest and avoid overly greasy, fatty foods before the dive
- This is life support equipment. Do NOT drag your regulators in the sand and do NOT put heavy tanks and weights on top of suits, BCS, and regulators.
- Your gear must be returned clean to the shop (there is a rinse bucket). You are responsible for returning your OWN equipment, so please keep track of which equipment is yours.
- Report any equipment problems to the shop.
