With the use of kayaks Adventure Sports gains access to areas of Monterey and Carmel Bay that would normally be inaccessible. Who wouldn't want to take a Friday off to go diving? With the First Friday dives you will always have a buddy to go out diving with. With the use of our specially outfitted kayaks we have access to some of the most beautiful dives in Big Sur and Carmel Bay. The First Friday dives provide new and old divers a chance to explore some of the most pristine locations of Carmel. Dives include all necessary rental gear, kayak rental and guide for 2 ocean dives.

No first Friday dive is ever the same, dive locations are determined based on conditions and can change last minute. Divers will meet at the Safeway parking lot in Carmel off of Rio Rd the morning of the dives and a dive site will be selected based on conditions and diver preference. Diving is all about what each individual wants to get out of it, if divers are looking for opportunities to hunt, take photographs or just enjoy the beauty

that Carmel bay and Big Sur have to offer Adventure Sports will find the best location for what the divers are seeking. Dive locations vary between Monastery Beach, Point Lobos, Still Water Cove, Cypress Point, Carmel River, and for those skilled and adventurous enough locations in Big Sur like Lobos Rocks, Yankee point, and Jade Cove. For divers with their own gear the price is reduced from \$90 to \$60. So come and join us in exploring the Carmel bay with the most efficient vehicle for diving.



Prerequisites:

- PADI Open Water Diver or equivalent
- ASU Kayak Diving training

Divers Must Provide:

- All SCUBA equipment (*may be rented*)
- Food to share for lunch

Fee Includes:

- 2 Guided Dives
- Rental Gear (not including gear bag, mask, snorkel, fins, booties, & gloves)
- Kayak Rental Fee
- Transportation of Kayaks for Dives

Costs:

- \$90 Diver Fee
- \$100 Kayak Training fee (if diver has not been previously trained by ASU)
- Additional cost may be added depending on dive location (Point Lobos, Still Water Cove, & Cypress Point)

Schedule:

- First Friday of Every Month Year Round
- Contact shop for available space and conditions
- Dives all day Friday, Divers must pick up any necessary gear Thursday before the dive

Cancellation Policy: Full refund if cancellation request received within 3 days of booking, or 7 days prior to start of class. No refund or credit or transfer will be permitted if request received within 6 days of start of class.
